### **PRIORITY MAIL "IS" our most important communication system.**

Please be sure that your child knows how they are going home in the afternoon. **If it is necessary to change their dismissal routine during the year, we will need that in writing and may be placed in Priority Mail.** Sometimes children get confused about dismissal and they might get upset; therefore we will only change in dismissal plans if you let us know in writing. This includes clubs or safety patrol. It is important to send a written excuse for any absence.

Your child will be having a small snack every day.

Please have your child to school at 9:00. The instructional day begins at 9:07. Children need time to unpack and get ready for the school day. We are looking forward to a great year!
