I am delighted to be your child's Kindergarten teacher for the 2019-20 school year! I look forward to a year of growth, learning and fun while we develop as a community of learners. We will be working together and sharing with each other all year. I am asking for these supplies by the first day of school. You and your child may drop off supplies and meet teachers on Wednesday, August 28th from 10 to 11 am. Please label your child's items marked ** below with their name. Supplies include;

- 1 plastic 2-pocket folder for notices/work**
- 1 large backpack (rolling backpacks are discouraged)**
- 4 boxes of 16 Crayola crayons
- 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 3 packages of baby wipes
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 1 package of white 3x5" un-ruled index cards
- 12 small glue sticks
- 1 pair of blunt-end child scissors**
- 2 packs of #2 pencils sharpened please!
- 1 pack of washable assorted Crayola markers**
- A 4 pack of thin Dry Erase markers
- 2 marble composition notebooks (one black/one colored)**
- 1 thick towel for resting (no mats please, space is limited)**
- 1 Ziploc bag of a seasonal change of clothing (underwear/socks)**
- 1 plastic shoe box with lid (please, no oversized, they won't fit)**
- 1 coloring book (as an option for indoor recess)
